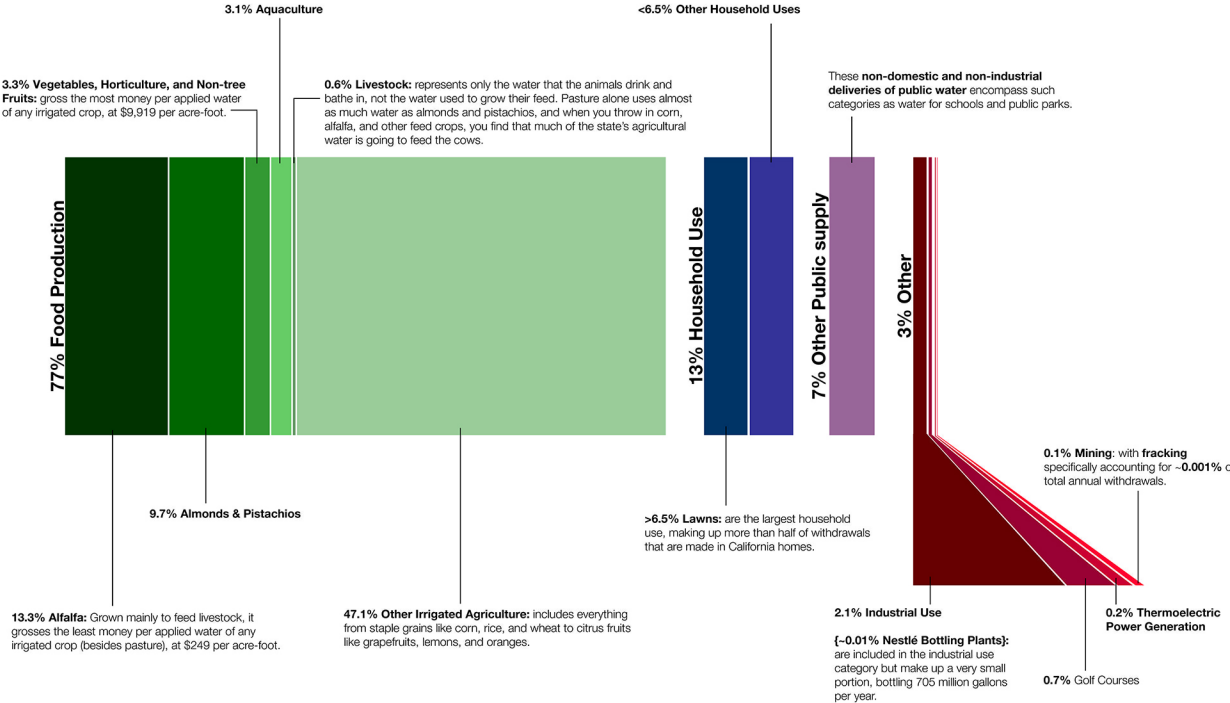


# A ROUGH BREAKDOWN OF ANNUAL FRESHWATER WITHDRAWALS IN CALIFORNIA

Just how much water do fracking, Nestlé, almonds, and lawns use?



\*All water use values are 2010 estimates, including California's total annual withdrawal of 11.4 trillion gallons. Exceptions include fracking and Nestlé bottled water, which are 2014 estimates.
