(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall award 1 2 additional funding under the Sanitation Facilities 3 Construction Program for the planning, design, construction, modernization, improvement, and renova-4 5 tion of water, sewer, and solid waste sanitation fa-6 cilities that are funded, in whole or part, by the In-7 dian Health Service through, or provided for in, a 8 contract or compact with the Indian Health Service 9 under the Indian Self-Determination and Education 10 Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 5301 et seq.). 11 (2) Priority for funding.—In awarding 12 funding to sanitation facilities under paragraph (1), 13 the Secretary shall prioritize sanitation facilities 14 with the highest deficiency level, as established in 15 the report. 16 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.— 17 (1) IN GENERAL.—There is authorized to be 18 appropriated to the Secretary to carry out this sec-19 tion \$1,335,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 20 2021 through 2025. 21 (2) REQUIREMENT.—Amounts made available 22 under paragraph (1) shall be in addition to any 23 amounts made available to carry out the purposes 24 described in subsection (c)(1) under any other provision of law.
