Dear Mr. Eggerding:

I approve Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC's (Mountain Valley) request filed April 22, 2024 as supplemented on May 21 and June 10, to place into service the Mountain Valley Pipeline Project in West Virginia and Virginia.

Your request is in compliance with environmental condition 10 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's October 13, 2017 *Order Issuing Certificates and Granting Abandonment Authority* for the Project (Order). This authorization is granted on the basis of Mountain Valley's recent construction status reports and supplemental filings, our regular compliance monitoring reporting, a staff inspection the week of May 13-17, and our communications with the Department of Transportation's Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration. We find that Mountain Valley has adequately stabilized the areas disturbed by construction and that restoration and stabilization of the construction work area is proceeding satisfactorily.

I remind you that Mountain Valley must comply with all applicable remaining terms and conditions of the above-referenced Order.
